Nomination Criteria

Nominations can be made by transplant recipients, donors, donor families and colleagues by **Tuesday 30th April, 2019** via the online nomination form on the TSANZ website (<https://www.tsanz.com.au/awardsandfellowships/index.asp>)

Eligibility and Entry Criteria

- Any clinician (including physicians, surgeons, nurses, psychologists, social workers, other allied health professionals) who provides care to patients and families in transplantation can be nominated
- Nominees must be practising in Australia or New Zealand
- Nominees do not have to be a member of TSANZ
- Optional - submit a photo of patient, clinician or both
- The judging panel will include the Award Chairs, a representative of TSANZ council, a representative of Transplant Australia and a patient representative.

Entries will be scored on the following criteria:

- Patient-focussed
- Involvement of patients/families in care
- Patient-centred effective communication
- Compassion and empathetic care
- Demonstrated impact on improved patient care and outcomes
